II. Call to Order:

IV. Approval of Minutes:

Secretary Weinheimer made a motion to accept the board meeting minutes for December 04, 2014 as presented. Director Wittig seconded. All voted for; motion carried.

V. Manager's Report:

<u>Financial Report</u> – Mr. Hudgins reported a checking account balance of \$105,287.99 and a money market balance of \$879,061.20. A budget vs. actual and the balance sheet for December were also presented. After discussion and review, Director Wittig made a motion to approve the financials as presented. Secretary Weinheimer seconded. All voted for; motion carried.

<u>Quarterly Investment Report</u> – Mr. Hudgins presented the board with the current investments of CBGCD funds. After discussion and review, Director Wittig made a motion to approve the investments as presented. Secretary Weinheimer seconded. All voted for; motion carried.

<u>Well Monitoring Update</u> – Mr. Hudgins presented the board with the monitor well levels as of January 01, 2015. Report shows an increase of 3 feet from the previous month with levels still below previous years.

<u>Exempt & Non Exempt Well Information Report</u>— Mr. Hudgins presented the Board with a detailed breakdown of current Exempt and Non Exempt Well Information for the 2014-2016 permitting term.

- VI. **Discussion To Approve Permit Applications:** After discussion and review of the new drill permit and replacement drill applications, Secretary Weinheimer made a motion to approve the permit application for Leedo Manufacturing and OP-05011009 for Clayton Schmidt. - VII. Review Draft Rules Regarding Critical Groundwater Depletion Area and Consider Any Changes to CBGCD Rules: The agenda item was tabled until the February board meeting. No action was taken.
- VIII. **Report from Intera Regarding Water Levels in Shallow Wells:** The Intera report will be addressed at the February meeting; the report is a draft report only. Intera has been asked to rework the report based on lack of documentation supporting recommendations. No action was taken.

- IX. Consider Proposing Legislation to Amend CBGCD Enabling Act: Wharton County Commissioners' Court passed a resolution on Monday, January 12, 2015 in support of CBGCD proposing legislation to amend CBGCD enabling act. Greg Ellis will continue to work with the appointed CBGCD legislative committee.

Review and Consider Four Resolutions/Orders for the City of El Campo: After review and discussion, Secretary Weinheimer made a motion to approve the 4 resolutions as presented for the properties to be used in the City of El Campo drainage project. Director Wittig seconded. All voted for; motion carried.
- XI. **Review Water Quality Results:** Mr. Hudgins presented the board with the data received from the water quality tests. The results show that all samples meet current safe drinking water standards. No action was taken.
