#### I. In Attendance:

### II. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 8:06 A.M.

## III. Public Comments:

None.

#### IV. Approval of Minutes:

Vice President Raun made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Director Wittig seconded. All voted for; motion carried.

#### V. Manager's Report:

<u>Financial Report</u> – Mr. Hudgins reported a checking account balance of \$15,065.45 and a money market balance of \$583,988.65. A budget vs. actual and a list of total District investments was also presented. The District has used right at 80% of the budget through the end of July. Director Wittig made a motion to approve the financial report as presented. Vice President Raun seconded. All voted for; motion carried.

<u>Well Registration Update</u> – Mr. Hudgins presented the Board with a detailed breakdown of current Exempt and Non Exempt Well Information. The current information sheet represents the 2008-2010 permit term water numbers. There are a total of 4,048 wells registered. 712 of the 4,048 are non exempt wells.

<u>Well Monitoring Update</u> – Mr. Hudgins presented the Board with the water level readings for the month of August. Water levels for August are either slightly higher than readings for July or stayed about even.

<u>*Water Use Report*</u> – Staff presented the Board with a report of the 2007 water usage. One hundred percent of the reports were reported on the summary sheet. Due to excessive rainfall in 2007, only 21% of the permitted water amounts have been used for this year.

<u>TAGD Meeting</u> – Mr. Hudgins attended the TAGD meeting in Austin, July 26 and July 27 and he gave a summary of that meeting. The next TAGD meeting will be at the end of October in Austin.

VI. **Review and Approve Permit Applications:** After discussion and review of the permit applications, Vice President Raun made a motion to approve the submitted permit applications as presented. Secretary Weinheimer seconded. All voted for; motion carried.

- VII. Order of November 4, 2008 Election: Secretary Weinheimer made a motion to order an Election for Directors for the November 4, 2008 election for the positions of Precinct #1 - Director, Precinct #3. President Gertson seconded. All voted for; motion carried.
- VIII. **District Investment Policy:** After discussion and review of the District Investment Policy, Secretary Weinheimer made a motion to accept the Investment Policy as presented. Director Wittig seconded. All voted for: motion carried.
- IX. Annual Evaluation of District Rules on Prevention of Groundwater Waste: The Board reviewed the District Rules on Prevention of Groundwater Waste. Vice President Raun made a motion to not make any changes to the current rules. Director Wittig seconded. All voted for; motion carried.
- X. **Participation in TCDRS Retirement Plan:** After discussion and review the authorization to maintain TCDRS plan provisions for plan year 2009, the Board tabled discussion until Staff presents a proposed plan to possibly increase the rate donation and matching funds for the District.
- XI. **Task Order No.9:** After discussion and review, President Gertson made a motion to approve the Task Order No. 9 submitted by Turner, Collie, & Braden, authorizing the task order for \$10,000 for funds to be used by T, C & B with prior approval of the General Manager for the period of July 22, 2008 through December 31, 2009. Vice President Raun seconded. All voted for; motion carried.
- XII. Engagement Letter from Reed & Associates, P.C. After discussion and review of the engagement letter from Reed & Associates P.C., Secretary Weinheimer made a motion to accept and sign the letter as presented to retain their services for the 2007-2008 fiscal year audit. Vice President Raun seconded. All voted for; motion carried.
- XIII. Budget Amendment: Director Wittig made a motion to decrease the budget item "Groundwater Modeling" by \$2,744 and increase the budget items "District Travel Expense; Lodging" by \$400, "Insurance; Vehicle" by \$344, "Office Supplies" by \$1,000 and "Salaries; Additional Staff" by \$1,000. Also, to increase "Revenues; Reserve Fund" by \$21,000 and to create a budget line item "Capital Outlay; Vehicle Purchase" with a budget of \$21,000 for the purchase of a new District vehicle. President Gertson seconded. All voted for; motion carried.
- XIV. **Budget Workshop:** The Board reviewed the proposed budget with District Staff. After discussion and review, Vice President Raun made a motion to propose the budget as presented and to propose a tax rate of 0.00706 cents per \$100 valuation. Director Wittig seconded. All voted for; motion carried.
- XV. **Unfinished Business:** Secretary Weinheimer would like Alcoa to present an update of the plume at the next general board meeting.
- XVI. Next Meeting: The next general board meeting was set for Tuesday, September 9, 2008 at 8:00 a.m. at the District Office, 109 E. Milam, Wharton, Texas.
