### I. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 8:03 A.M. by President Gertson.

## **III.** Approval of Minutes:

Director Berglund made a motion to accept the meeting and permit hearing minutes as presented for July 16, 2019. Secretary Weinheimer seconded. All voted for; motion carried.

# V. Manager's Report:

<u>Financial Report</u> – Mr. Hudgins reported a checking account balance of \$336,278.21; a money market balance of \$137,045.60; 2018 CD balance of \$400,000; 2019 CD balance 520,718.78. A budget vs. actual and the balance sheet for July was also presented. After discussion and review, Director Berglund made a motion to approve the financials as presented. Secretary Weinheimer seconded. All voted for; motion carried.

<u>Well Monitoring Update</u> – Mr. Hudgins presented the board with the monitor well levels as of August 01, 2019. The index well graph shows a 5-feet decline from the previous month of July. The levels are 5 feet higher than August 2018 levels. The critical depletion study area shows a similar trend to the index well graph. Mr. Hudgins is continuing to work toward drilling the replacement monitor wells.

Vice-President Raun made the motion to propose the 2019-2020 budget as presented which would necessitate a Tax Rate of \$0.0080/100 valuation. Director Berglund seconded. - IV. **Review and Propose 2019-2020 Tax Rate:** Vice-President Raun made a motion to propose a Tax Rate of \$0.0080/100 valuation. Director Berglund seconded. All voted for; motion carried.
- X. Review and Discuss Renewal Options to Certificate of Deposit #50016679: Mr. Hudgins presented the board with the maturity date of the certificate of deposit and discussed investment options. After discussion, Vice-President Raun made a motion to reinvest the certificate of deposit at the highest available rate subject to Mr. Hudgins' judgement. Director Berglund seconded. All voted for; motion carried.
- XI. **Review and Discuss Draft Contract with GM Ellis Law Firm:** Greg Ellis presented and discussed the draft contract with the board. After review and discussion, Director Berglund made a motion to approved the contract with the agreement that CBGCD will be responsible for 60% and Coastal Plains GCD will be responsible for 40% which will be invoiced by Coastal Bend GCD. Vice-President Raun Seconded. All voted for; motion carried.

Review Draft Proposed CBGCD Rule Amendments Related to Public Comment at Board Meetings, Term of Permit Amendments, and Export Permit Term Renewals: Mr. Hudgins presented the board with the draft CBGCD rule amendments.
