<u>Well Monitoring Update</u> – Mr. Hudgins presented the board with the monthly monitor well levels as of November 2023. The index well graph shows 3-feet recovery from the previous month of October 2023 and 3.5 feet lower than November 2022. The Lissie transducer shows a similar trend to the index wells and the 4th lowest level since starting the monitoring in October 2014.
